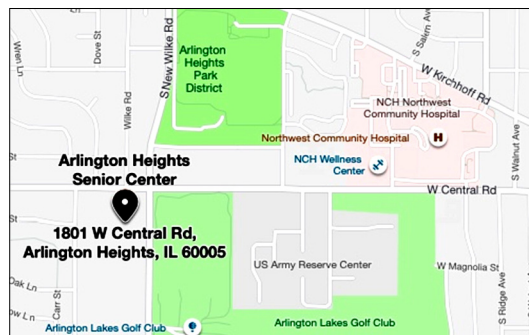
- Promotes the study of genealogy and history.
